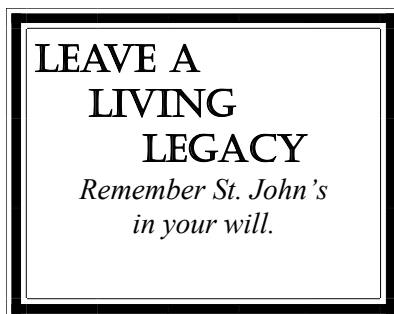
An 18 quart roaster oven has been residing in Room A for several weeks. If this belongs to you, please take it home. Thank you.
